Seller Agrees To The Following:

- 1. Seller agrees to provide registration papers on this cat/kitten if purchased as a Pet, upon presentation of veterinarian's certificate of neuter or spay. If purchased as a Show or Breeder, Seller will provide registration papers upon Purchaser's notification that the cat/kitten is of agreed upon quality.
- 2. Health Guarantee: To the best of the Seller's knowledge, Purchaser is receiving a healthy cat/kitten free from infectious disease, or life threatening congenital defects. To validate this Guarantee, Purchaser must have his/her own veterinarian inspect said cat/kitten within seven (7) working days of purchase and if any serious or life threatening illness is found Purchaser must contact Seller, and may at his/her option, either 1) return said cat/kitten for full refund or 2) return said cat/kitten to Seller for replacement cat/kitten if available.
